VILLAGE UPDATE

With the Summer Season upon us, all Village Departments are busy attempting to make improvements as well as to perform needed maintenance.

The Cemetery Mowing Crew has been extremely busy with being short-handed on employees and the Spring grass growth. All the heavy rains have not helped them either. They have numerous properties to mow and not just the cemeteries. Special emphasis is always put on the cemeteries and especially with the Memorial Day Holiday.

The Park crew is finally getting some relief from constant ballfield maintenance and switching concentration to the Swimming Pool and various maintenance projects throughout the park. We have a great group of young people working at the pool and concessions this year as well as our seasoned employees. The Village has provided employment for 33 seasonal staff members at the park this year. The fountain has been absent for a time but is now back in the Park Rotary Lake spraying in all its glory. The kayak launch ramp and dock is back in the lake as well and creates an easy place to board your kayak and to load supplies onto your watercraft. The Independence Day celebration will take place on Saturday July 2nd, 2022 with the alternate rain date being Sunday July 3rd. The Chamber of Commerce has cancelled their annual chicken barbecue for this year but other food vendors will be present with some great dining choices. The fireworks will begin at dark.

The Street Department has been busy with patching streets and alleys as well as spreading stone on the unpaved areas to repair winters damage. They are hoping to do some alley paving this year.

The Slope Creek Waterline Project has been awarded to Rudzik Excavating of Struthers, Ohio for \$5,752,174.38. Construction is expected to take place over a 10 to 12 month period and should begin in the next few months as materials become available.

The Westview Drive Sewage Lift Station and Force Main Replacement Project is out for bid with the opening date set as June 23rd. Hoping to complete this project in 2022. American Rescue Plan Funding will be used to finance the project.

As we enter each season we are not only handling the tasks that it presents but already beginning to plan for the next season to follow and the challenges that may be ahead.

The Village of Barnesville has implemented the CodeRED emergency alert high-speed notification system. The CodeRED system gives Village officials the ability to quickly deliver pre-recorded telephone notifications and informational messages to targeted areas or to the entire village.

Notifications can be received by phone, text message, email, and by a free mobile app. The system is provided to the Village by Belmont County 911.
