VILLAGE UPDATE

There is much going on in the Village as we go into the Fall season.

The Slope Creek Waterline Project is nearing construction with plans to begin in September. This will be a 10 to 12 month project to install the new pump house and over 4 miles of 16" pipeline.

The Westview Drive Sewage Lift Station and Force Main Replacement Project was awarded to Ohio- WV Excavating and should also go into construction in September and be completed by Spring.

The Intersection Safety Improvements Project is in full swing at the intersections of Chestnut & Main as well as South Street & S. Chestnut. This project is completely funded through the Governor's Office by gas tax funds. The Village will have the benefit of mass arms to hold the traffic lights rather than cables and will receive all new traffic lights and controls separating the two intersections. The new system will feature walk lights also. This will be a huge improvement for the community.

The Village is currently working with ODOT on the Tunnel & Trail Project. The Village has been awarded 2.1 million dollars for this project to provide drainage and a liner for the tunnel complete with lighting as well as wing walls for bank stabilization and a paved walkway from South Street to St. Rt. 147.

Barnesville Public works along with Warren & Somerset Township employees have been paving some alleys and our Fall leaf pickup will soon begin with the anticipated start date of October 15th and continuing to December 15th based on weather conditions. The leafs must be placed in the paper biodegradable compostable bags and left curbside. No particular route is followed and they will be picked up as time allows.

Property Maintenance

The Village of Barnesville has a property maintenance code in place chapter 1381. Property owners are reminded to adhere to this code. Every premises and structure shall be maintained in good repair and kept free of all nuisances, health, safety, and fire hazards, unsanitary conditions and abate the same. Buildings should be maintained to be weather and water tight and free of deterioration. Inoperable vehicles shall be stored within fully enclosed buildings or other locations not exposed to public view, or shall be removed from the premises. Whoever violates this section will be served with a 30-day notice to abate and given a Mayor's Court appearance if not abated.

Fall Leaf Pickup

The Barnesville Public Works will be picking up leaves that are left curbside by residents of the Village of Barnesville, as long as they are contained in paper biodegradable compostable bags. No plastic trash bags will be accepted. Bags must contain leaves only and will be picked up as time allows. No specific schedule will be followed. The collection will begin Oct. 15 and will end Dec. 15. Also, there is no longer a drop-off point at the Depot, and will be a dumping violation if found dropping off there.

Weather Alerts

The Village social media accounts have been connected to a service called Weatherology to provide real-time weather alerts when a weather event is issued by the National Weather Service. Once a weather event is issued, it will automatically be posted onto the Village of Barnesville Facebook & Twitter accounts. This will provide an extra layer of notification of weather events. In addition to this the Village of Barnesville utilizes the CodeRED Weather Warnings. These alerts are sent to the numbers in our database in the event of severe weather. When the National Weather Service issues a Severe Thunderstorm Warning, Tornado Warning or Flash Flood Warning you will receive an emergency phone call only if you are in the projected path of the storm. In the event of a Severe Winter Storm Warning issued by the National Weather Service, alerts are sent via email and text. If you have not signed up for CodeRED you can do so by visiting www.alerts.barnesvilleohio.com.
