VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville, Ohio, finds it to be in the best interest of the Village to enter into an oil and gas lease for the minerals it owns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator is authorized to advertise for proposals to lease the oil and gas minerals owned by the Village of Barnesville in accordance with O.R.C. §721.03, identified as approximately 10.376 acres located in Warren Township, more particularly described in the General Warranty Deed recorded in Volume 786, Page 206, of the Deed Records of Belmont County, Ohio.


Section 2: That the Village Administrator is authorized to receive such proposals for leasing the Village oil and gas minerals at his office at Barnesville, Ohio, until \_\_\_\_\_ at which time the proposals will be opened and read.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Barnesville in order to lease oil and gas minerals owned.


Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
