- a. Chief Hall presented Council with the Fire and EMS Departments Report Summary for December 2024, along with the Annual Report Summary for 2024.
- b. Chief Sirianni provided Council with the Police Department's Report Summary for December 2024, along with the Annual Report Summary for 2024.
- c. Mayor Hershberger, on behalf of Police Chief Sirianni, asked Council to consider increasing the Police clothing allowance by \$200. Chief Sirianni provided an itemized list that Officers need and the approximate costs. This prompted a discussion to increase the clothing allowance for all full time workers in each department. Fire Chief Hall stated an increase for the EMS Department would be determined on the Employees' hours worked.
- Mr. McCort made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Misner to amend the current Ordinances for clothing allowances to reflex an increase of \$200 for all full time Employees in all Departments, and the EMS Department's increase will be determined on the Employees' hours worked per Chief Hall.

### 10 Old Business

- a. Mayor Hershberger discussed with Council the roof replacement for the Depot. A discussion was held on checking into other options that may be available while still keeping the historical look, value and registry. Mayor Hershberger to look into possibly more options available and provide this to Council.
- b. Mayor Hershberger informed Council that the Depot Committee will sublease office space at the Depot to Cast and Baker during the construction of the Rails to Trails and Tunnel Project. Mayor Hershberger detailed the terms and stated if would be for approximately ten months.

Council expressed their approval. Richard Myser Village Solicitor to draft the lease.

- c. A work session was scheduled for Tuesday, January 21, 2025 at 9:00 am with the Ohio EPA to discuss a water project and a work session to follow at 11:00 am to discuss more details regarding funding support for the State Theater.
- d. Councilman Terry McCort discussed with Council doing some upgrades to the Bohandy Building and an estimate he received from Greg Williams. A discussion was held on interior improvements including flooring, an additional bathroom, drywall and painting. Mr. McCort suggested utilizing Employees from the Park and Cemetery Departments during their slow time.
- Mr. McCort asked Council to authorize improvement costs up to \$45,000.
