A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER SUPPLY REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT (WSRLA) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE FOR DESIGN OF WATERLINE EXTENSION TO HENDRYSBURG, FAIRVIEW AND MT. OLIVETT.

Whereas, the Village of Barnesville seeks to design waterline extension to the areas of Hendrysburg, Fairview and Mt. Olivett; and

Whereas, the Village of Barnesville intends to apply for Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) for the design of waterline extension to Hendrysburg, Fairview and Mt. Olivett; and

Whereas, the Ohio Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Barnesville, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the Village of Barnesville be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WSRLA loan, sign all documents for and enter a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for design of waterline extension to Hendrysburg, Fairview and Mt. Olivett on behalf of the Village of Barnesville, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the dedicated source of repayment will be water user fees.

SECTION 3. That is resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECODIFICATION, EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF BARNESVILLE, OHIO

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Barnesville, Ohio; and
