**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE
AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION (ARC) PROGRAM
AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) and Ohio Governor's Office of Appalachia (GOA) provide financial assistance for equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville is planning to make capital improvements for the Barnesville North Water Extension Project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the ARC and GOA programs; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville is requesting a grant from the ARC program in the amount of \$250,000 for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville has matching funds from an EPA WSRLA loan for said project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Council of the Village of Barnesville that:

Section 1. The Mayor of Barnesville is hereby authorized to apply to the ARC program for funds as described above.

Section 2. The Mayor of Barnesville is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Barnesville to obtain needed funds for the Barnesville North Water Extension project.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF
BARNESVILLE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER SUPPLY
REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT (WSRLA) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE
VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WATERLINE EXTENSION
TO HENDRYSBURG, FAIRVIEW AND MT. OLIVETT AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville seeks to construct waterline extension to the areas of Hendrysburg, Fairview and Mt. Olivett; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville intends to apply for Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) for the construction of waterline extension to Hendrysburg, Fairview and Mt. Olivett; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Barnesville, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor of the Village of Barnesville be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WSRLA loan, sign all documents for and enter a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for construction of waterline extension to Hendrysburg, Fairview and Mt. Olivett on behalf of the Village of Barnesville, Ohio.

Section 2. The dedicated source of repayment will be water user fees.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Barnesville to obtain needed funds for the Barnesville North Water Extension project.
