ORDINANCE NO. 4048

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE
JEFFERSON BELMONT REGIONAL SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Jefferson Belmont Regional Solid Waste Authority, by its Board of Trustees, has adopted an amended Solid Waste Management Plan for the Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3734.55(B), the Board of County Commissioners and the legislative authority of each municipal corporation or township under the jurisdiction of the Authority, must approve or disapprove the amended Plan by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnesville, Belmont County, Ohio have reviewed the amended Plan and considered it at a duly called meeting; and

WHEREAS, the amended Plan furthers the public interest; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Jefferson Belmont Regional Solid Waste Authority, adopted by the Board of Trustees on June 15, 2026, is hereby approved;
