RESOLUTION NUMBER #4056

**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF
CHRIS HENDERSHOT AS FIRE CHIEF AND
SILAS TRACY AS ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF
FOR THE VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE, OHIO,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, there is need for the appointment of a new Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief for the Village of Barnesville, effective October 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Hershberger has interviewed and has appointed Chris Hendershot as Fire Chief and Silas Tracy as Assistant Fire Chief in accordance with Section 139.02 of the Barnesville Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Hershberger has submitted these names to the Barnesville Council for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Barnesville:

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of Barnesville hereby confirms and approves the appointment of Chris Hendershot as Fire Chief, effective October 1, 2026, in accordance with the appointment of Mayor Hershberger and in accordance with Section 139.02 of the Barnesville Ordinances.

Section 2. That the Council of the Village of Barnesville hereby confirms and approves the appointment of Silas Tracy as Assistant Fire Chief, effective October 1, 2026, in accordance with the appointment of Mayor Hershberger and in accordance with Section 139.02 of the Barnesville Ordinances.

Section 3. That the Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief are hereby appointed to perform their duties in accordance with Section 139.03 and 139.04 of the Barnesville Municipal Code and are to serve for an indefinite time, with their salaries to be set in accordance with Ordinance No.

4034 of the Barnesville Municipal Code.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the Village of Barnesville as it is necessary to protect the public interest, promote the general health, safety, and welfare of the community, and to otherwise benefit the village.

RESOLUTION NUMBER #4057

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE
ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
AS A RESULT OF AN EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO
SECTION 735.051 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE
TO PERMIT A CONTRACT TO COMPLETE THE
SOUTH BROADWAY STREET PROJECT
IN THE VILLAGE OF BARNESVILLE
WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING OF THE PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, as a result of the culvert and water line replacement project in the Village of Barnesville, a portion of South Broadway Street in the Village of Barnesville, Ohio, has fallen into serious and dangerous disrepair, causing a health and safety concern to the citizens of the Village of Barnesville; and

WHEREAS, the cost to complete this project and repaving of South Broadway Street will exceed the bidding threshold limitation of \$79,568.00, which requires the Village to proceed with public bidding to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the Village has contacted the company of Shelly and Sands Paving to provide an estimate and plans for completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administration is satisfied with the experience and qualifications of Shelly and Sands Paving to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, a bidding process would require four (4) to six (6) weeks to complete, which will be beyond the time for asphalt plans to be open and operating to be able to complete this project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council of the Village of Barnesville, Ohio:

Section 1: Hereby declares that a "real and present emergency has arisen" pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code regarding the reconstruction and repaving project of South

Broadway Street in the Village of Barnesville, requiring the Village Administration to proceed to contract with the company known as Shelly and Sands Paving;

Section 2: That the Village authorizes the Village Administrator to proceed to contract with the company of Shelly and Sands Paving to complete the project for the repaving of South Broadway Street in the Village of Barnesville and to take whatever measures are necessary to complete this project, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code without public bidding;

Section 3: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Barnesville.
